AIR FORCE HONOR GUARD COMES TO CHARLESTON AFB

BOLLING AIR FORCE BASE, Washington, D.C.-- The U.S. Air Force Honor Guard, the Air Force's elite ceremonial unit, is offering rewarding opportunities and career broadening experiences to NCOs and Senior NCOs in the Southeast region Aug. 12 at Charleston AFB.

"The recruiting team will set up briefings at each base and be available to answer questions about who we are and what we do and talk about the application process," said Chief Master Sergeant William Greene III, enlisted manager at the unit. "Our goal is to interest and attract men and women who may be interested in a special duty tour at the Honor Guard." In addition, the USAF Honor Guard Drill Team, traveling with the recruiting team, will perform at each base.

The USAF Honor Guard currently participates in honors funerals at Arlington National Cemetery, arrival/departure ceremonies at the White House and Pentagon for civilian and military leaders from foreign countries; wreath layings at the Tomb of the Unknowns in Arlington National Cemetery; and Presidential inaugurations.

Ceremonial guardsmen will be available to answer questions after the briefing. An assignment with the Honor Guard requires a special duty package, and is a three-year controlled tour.
