### 17<sup>th</sup> EXPEDITIONARY AIRLIFT SQUADRON CELEBRATES 1000<sup>TH</sup> MISSION

**What:** Lt. Col. Norton, 17th Expeditionary Airlift Squadron commander, and Maj. Jeff Myers, aircraft mission commander, will be conducting telephone interviews from Rhein-Main AB, Germany about the 1000<sup>th</sup> C-17 airlift mission flown in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.
