Court-Martial:

An airman basic was found guilty by a Special Court-Martial for being Absent Without Leave for 10 days, and failing to arrive at work on time on five other occasions. He was sentenced to 3 months confinement.

Article 15 actions:

An airman made a false statement under oath. He stated to an investigator he had never spoken to another airman, when in fact, he communicated a threat to injure this airman if he went on leave.

Punishment: He received a suspended reduction to airman basic, restriction to Charleston AFB for 10 days and 30 days extra duty.

A senior airman assaulted his wife. Additionally, he was ordered to have no contact with his wife. He failed to obey the order.

Punishment: He received a reduction to the grade of airman first class and a suspended reduction to Airman.

A staff sergeant destroyed mail addressed to his unit commander.

Punishment: He received forfeiture of \$968 pay per month for 2 months, 30 days extra duty and a reprimand.

A staff sergeant failed to obey a lawful order to have no contact with another service member.

Punishment: He received reduction to the grade of senior airman, forfeiture of \$796 pay, 30 days extra

duty and a reprimand.

A senior airman was found derelict in her duties when she gave her civilian friend the keys to her vehicle and her dormitory room although she knew that the individual was barred from CAFB.

Punishment: She received a suspended reduction to airman first class, suspended forfeiture of \$667 pay per month for 2 months and a reprimand.

A technical sergeant took indecent liberties with his 20 year-old stepdaughter.

Punishment: He received a suspended reduction to staff sergeant and a reprimand.

An airman first class caused \$526.60 worth of damage to another service member's car by kicking the door. This airman first class also used provoking words to another service member, and pushed that member from behind. He also pushed another member on her shoulders.

Punishment: He received a reduction to airman, restriction to CAFB for 30 days, 45 days extra duty and a reprimand.

An airman first class violated a lawful general instruction, by wrongfully processing and displaying obscene images on a United States computer.

Punishment: The airman first class received a reduction to the grade of airman and a reprimand.

A staff sergeant failed to go to his appointed place of duty.

Punishment: He received a reduction to the grade of senior airman and 15 days extra duty.

An airman first class used disrespectful language towards a non-commissioned officer, and failed to obey a lawful order to have no contact with another member of the service.

Punishment: The airman first class received a suspended reduction to Airman, restriction to CAFB for 14 days, 14 days extra duty and a reprimand.

An airman first class was

AWOL for three days and failed to obey a lawful order to have no contact with another service member.

Punishment: The airman first class received a reduction to airman and a reprimand.

An airman first class failed to obey a lawful order to have no contact with another service member.

Punishment: The airman first class received a suspended reduction to airman, 30 days extra duty and a reprimand.

A senior airman failed to obey a lawful order to have no contact with another service member.

Punishment: The senior airman received a suspended reduction to airman first class, 30 days extra duty and a reprimand.

Vacation actions:

An airman first class had the portion of his suspended Article 15 punishment vacated for failing to go and failing to obey a lawful order to complete his extra duty.

A senior airman had the portion of his suspended Article 15 punishment vacated for reckless driving.

An airman first class had the portion of his suspended Article 15 punishment vacated for failing to go on three separate occasions.

A senior airman had the portion of his suspended Article 15 punishment vacated for failing to maintain valid insurance on his car.

An airman first class had the portion of her suspended Article 15 punishment vacated for failing to go.

Suspensions:

An airman first class received an Article 15 for failing to go to his mandatory appointment at Family Advocacy. His punishment was a reduction to airman first class, 30 days extra duty and a reprimand. His punishment was later suspended for good behavior.

An airman first class filed a fraudulent travel voucher for expenses associated with the evacuation of Hurricane Floyd in the amount of \$196.29. He claimed he evacuated to Maryland, when in fact, he went to a location in South Carolina. His

punishment was a reduction to the grade of airman, forfeiture of \$100 pay per month for 2 months, restriction to CAFB for 15 days and 30 days extra duty. His punishment was later suspended for good behavior.

An airman first class filed a fraudulent travel voucher for expenses associated with the evacuation of Hurricane Floyd in the amount of \$425. He claimed he evacuated to Ohio, when in fact, he remained in Charleston. His punishment was a reduction to the grade of airman, forfeiture of \$200 pay per month for 2 months, restriction to CAFB for 15 days and 30 days extra duty. His punishment was later suspended for good behavior.

Remission:

An airman first class received an Article 15 for using a government PIN number to make personal long distance telephone calls in the amount of \$481.01. His punishment was a suspended reduction to airman, 14 days extra duty and a reprimand. His punishment was later remitted for good behavior.

Administrative discharges:

A senior airman was discharged for failure to meet Weight and Body Fat Management Standards. The member was separated with an honorable discharge.

Three airman first class, one airman and two airman basic were discharged for minor disciplinary infractions. All members were separated with general discharges.

An airman basic was discharged for drug abuse. The member was separated with an entry-level discharge.

A senior airman was discharged for a civilian conviction and for commission of a serious offense. The member was separated with an other than honorable conditions discharge.

An airman first class was discharged for a mental disorder. The member was separated with an honorable discharge.

An airman basic was discharged for misconduct. The member was separated with a general discharge.
